FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH GENERAL ENDOWNMENT FUND GRANT APPLICATION ANNOUNCEMENT

The General Endowment Fund was established by the congregation of First Lutheran Church to provide a perpetual source of income to: <u>support the ongoing ministry of the Church, to support local, regional</u> <u>and world missions, and to support capital projects including major renovations, capital repairs and</u> <u>building of new facilities</u>.

The provisions of the General Endowment Fund allow up to 5% of the value of the fund to be available for grants during a given year. Based on the 12/31/15 value of \$580,365, \$29,028 can be available during 2016 for grants that fulfill the purpose of the fund. The Endowment Committee, which was established to manage and grow the fund, has developed procedures for soliciting and processing grant requests.

The Committee is currently asking the congregation to submit grant applications that conform with the purpose of the General Endowment Fund. **If you wish to apply for a grant, please submit a completed application to the church office by October 28, 2016**. An application is included in this newsletter and is also available at the First Lutheran Church website <u>www.bottineauflc.org</u> and at the Church office. During the 1st week in November, the Endowment Committee will review grant applications and forward their recommendations to the Church Council for review and action.

This is the second and final round of grant solicitations for 2016. In April of this year, the Endowment Committee awarded a total of \$1,450 in grants to two recipients.
